AUTHORITY: [Wis. Stats. 19.45\(2\)](#)
Chapter ER-Pers 24

SCOPE: - to define "anything of value"
- to establish state policy with respect to unlawful benefits to state employes and public officials

DEFINITION: I. "Anything of value" means any money or property, favor, service, payment, advance, forbearance, loan, or promise of future employment, but does not include compensation and expenses paid by the state, fees, honorariums and expenses which are permitted and reported under s. 19.56, political contributions which are reported under ch. 11, or hospitality extended for a purpose unrelated to state business by a person other than an organization.

CONTENT: I. No state employe or public official may use his or her public position or office to obtain financial gain or anything of substantial value for the private benefit of himself or herself or his or her immediate family, or for an organization with which he or she is associated.
